ODC/Dance *The Velveteen Rabbit*

Minnesota ELA Anchor Standard: Prepare for and participate effectively in a range of conversations and collaborations with diverse partners, building on others' ideas and expressing their own clearly and persuasively.

Learning Target: Share dialogue with others about what was viewed in the performance to build greater understanding.

Directions: The students will share dialogue in small groups of 3-4 to talk about the performance. Specifically, students will respond to the following questions:

- 1. What kind of toys do you like most?
 - **a.** Why?
 - **b.** How do they make you feel?
- 2. In The Velveteen Rabbit, the boy feels his rabbit is real but is told by others it is not.
 - a. Why does he feel the Velveteen Rabbit is real?
 - b. Why do others say the Velveteen Rabbit is not real?
- **3.** Who is right?
 - a. Is the Velveteen Rabbit real or not?
 - b. How do you know?
- 4. What do you think are the meanings found in The Velveteen Rabbit?

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
